

Lemon Gorilla is a sativa-dominant hybrid cannabis strain, created by crossing Super Lemon Haze and GG#4. Although the parent strains are both highly regarded for their potent psychoactive effects, Lemon Gorilla is reportedly a bit milder.

The Lemon Gorilla buds have wavy, emerald and lime-green leaves. Long, dark-orange pistils are scattered about, while a resinous coat of gold trichome hairs cover the buds, adding streaks of amber. This strain smells like sage, lemon-citrus, and fresh mint. Smoking or vaping Lemon Gorilla releases a fresh spearmint flavor, with hints of lemon and sage.

Our Lemon Gorilla tested just under 20% THC, with users reporting a mild, psychoactive euphoria, along with a sedative body buzz. The dominant terpene, Terpinolene, is known to contribute to sedating effects. This relaxing effect is, according to some reviewers, enough on the body to help ease chronic pain and spasming. Despite this sedation, many users found the smooth cerebral euphoria energizing and mild enough as to not hinder their focus. Although most users found that Lemon Gorilla's psychoactive effects were not as intense as its parent strains, they say it may still be worth a try for those seeking milder relief from anxiety, depression, cramps, chronic pain, and stiffness.
